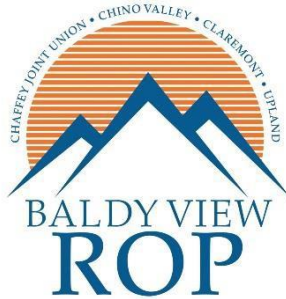

PREPARATION OF BID FORM

In order to receive consideration proposals must be received on or before the advertised closing date and not later than the time displayed therein. Proposals shall be submitted on the form(s) provided by the District. All blanks in the bid form must be appropriately filled in. Any bid received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids will be returned to the bidder unopened.

The bids will be opened and read in open session at the time and location listed in the Notice to Bidders. District reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and be the sole judge regarding the suitability of the products, services or supplies offered, and whether deviations are acceptable. District further reserves the right to not necessarily purchase all items nor the full quantity of each item listed in the bid document.

BID SECURITY

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashiers' check payable to the District or a satisfactory bid bond in favor of the District, executed by the bidder as principal and a satisfactory surety, in an amount not less than 10% of the maximum of the bid. The check or bid bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder shall execute the contract if it be awarded to him in conformity with the contract.

SIGNATURE

Bid must be signed in the name of the bidder and must bear the signature in longhand of the person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the bidder.

MODIFICATIONS

Changes in or additions to the bid form, recapitulations of the work bid upon, alternative proposals, or any other modification of the bid form which is not specifically called for in the contract documents may result in the District's rejection of the bid as not being responsive to the invitation to bid.

ERASURES

Bid submitted must not contain any erasures, interlineation, or other corrections unless each such correction is suitably authenticated by affixing in the margin adjacent to the correction the surname or surnames of the persons signing the bid. In the case of an error in an extension the unit price upon which the extension is based shall take precedence.

WITHDRAW OF BIDS

Any bidder may withdraw his bid either personally by written request, or by telegraphic request confirmed in the manner specified above any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

The Baldy View Regional Occupation Program and its Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding. The award of the contract, if made by the District, will be to the lowest responsible bidder on an item by item basis. District realizes that conditions other than price are important and may award based on individual items bid, or any combination of individual items, or upon a cumulative total of all items bid; whichever method is determined to be in its best interests; may reject any or all bids, any part of a bid, or may waive any informality in a bid.

TAXES

Do not include California State Sales or Use Tax in the unit price; taxes will be added by the District. The Federal Excise Tax is not applicable.

EVIDENCE OF RESPONSIBILITY

Upon the request of the District, a bidder whose bid is under consideration for the award of the contract shall submit promptly to the District satisfactory evidence showing the bidders financial resources, his experience in the field and his organization or other factors contributing to the successful execution and completion of the contract.

BID DEPOSIT RETURN

Deposits of three or more low bidders, the number being at the discretion of the District, will be held for sixty (60) days or until posting by the successful bidder of the return of executed copies of the appropriate agreement form at which time the deposits will be returned.

FORFEITURE FOR FAILURE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT

In the event the bidder to whom an award is made fails or refuses to execute the contract within five calendar days from the date receiving notification that he is the bidder to whom the contract is awarded, the District may declare bidder's bid deposit or bond forfeited as damages caused by the failure of the bidder to enter into the contract, and may award the work to the next lowest bidder, or may call for new bids.

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION

It is the policy of the District that in connection with all work performed, materials purchased or supplies provided under any contracts, there be no discrimination against any prospective or active employee engaged in the work because of race, color, ancestry, national origin, religious creed, sex, age or marital status. The supplier agrees to comply with applicable Federal and California laws including, but not limited to, the California Fair Employment Practice Act, beginning with Labor Code section 1410 and Labor Code section 1735. In addition, the supplier agrees to require like compliance by any sub-suppliers employed on the work by him.

WARRANTY/GUARANTEE

Contractor shall provide District with a warranty/guarantee on all equipment and material for one (1) year.

BRAND OR TRADE NAMES AS A DESCRIPTION

Certain specifications, brand names and the like are set forth for the purpose of setting a standard and are not intended to preclude any vendor from bidding who can substantially meet these specifications. Vendors may propose equipment equal to those specified herein, but each deviation from the specification must be set forth in detail. The successful bidder, pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 3400 will be provided a period of time prior to the award of the contract for submission of data substantiating a request for substitution of an "or equal" item.

TIME FOR OPENING

The time stated in the Notice to Contractors Calling for Bids, the Transmittal Letter, Schedule of Important Dates, and other places in this document is interpreted to mean the exact hour stated. That is if the closing time is 2:00 p.m. Bids received in the first minute of the two o'clock hour will be deemed late and not accepted.

SAMPLE DOCUMENTS

This bid contains sample documents; Bid Bond and Non-Collusion Affidavit. If bidder chooses to use the sample bond document, they must be executed by the appropriate surety.

FREIGHT TERMS

All prices shall be quoted F.O.B. destination, unpacked, assembled (if necessary) to the designated site at the time of order. No additional freight, drayage or labor charges will be permitted. Bids which are conditional upon an "all or nothing" clause for favorable terms or delivery will not be considered.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

While engaging in carrying out the terms and conditions of the purchase order, the vendor is an independent contractor and not an officer or agent of the District. The supplier should maintain adequate insurance to protect his interests.

SUBSTITUTIONS FOR SPECIFIED ITEMS

Whenever in these specifications any equipment or material is indicated or specified by patent or proprietary name or by the name of a manufacturer, such specifications shall be deemed to be used for the purpose of facilitating description of the equipment or materials desired and shall be deemed to be followed by the words "or equal". Bidders may propose equipment or materials equal to those specified herein, but must furnish complete specifications of each item and, if requested to do so, a sample of the item proposed. Such specifications and samples must be furnished no later than fifteen (15) days prior to bid opening at no cost or obligation to the District for the purposes of testing and evaluation. The District will notify bidder not less than five (5) days prior to the bid deadline whether the requested substitution has been approved as an "or equal" to the specified equipment or material. If not consumed or destroyed in such testing, the sample will be returned to the vendor after award of bid is made. If an alternate has been indicated but rejected by the District as not being an "or equal," bidder agrees that by submitting its bid, bidder shall provide the specified equipment or material. Unless an alternate make and model is indicated in the space provided, it is agreed all items proposed are as named in the specifications. Bids submitted without complete information may be rejected as non-responsive. Substitution of equipment after the award will not

be permitted.
